ColoHouse is located on the same dual power sub stations that service local hospitals, federal and state courthouses, which equates to priority turn-up for our facility.

HARDENED INFRASTRUCTURE

Our SSAE 16 certified data center is prepared for these events with N+1 Technology, UPS batteries, dual generators, and redundant power feeds.

As always, ColoHouse is open 24/7. Additionally, we have support and engineering staff available in preparation for and during any storm related complications.

PREPARATION & REDUNDANT POWER

- ✓ Two diesel generators paralleled – feeding the UPS simultaneously
- ✓ An additional roll-up generator can also be integrated with the existing parallel equipment
- ✓ Two separate fuel tanks located in geographically diverse regions
- ✓ Generator fuel capacity will run for approximately six and a half days without refueling
- ✓ ColoHouse has a 24-hour emergency fuel contract
- ✓ As an added precaution, Digital Realty Trust has a 24-hour emergency fuel policy
- ✓ ColoHouse Operations performs additional generator tests in preparation for hurricane season
- ✓ A cross functional preparedness team and recovery team have been identified in the event of a disaster
